Linden Avenue Middle School Community Playground Build

Where: Linden Avenue Middle School, Northeast Field

What: The new, architect-designed, play area will feature a pod climber, swiggle knots, chinning bar, wobble pods, balance beam, lolliladder, cargo net, spiderwalk, and a variety of other new equipment. There will be an outdoor classroom space that will feature an awning for shade and furniture to be used as an alternative learning site. From its inception, students have been closely involved in the planning and selection of equipment to ensure suitable pieces were selected for students at LAMS.

When: The Community build will begin on August 5th and continue on August 6th, 7th and 12th.

Who: Any and all Red Hook community members, including middle and high school students, are welcome to volunteer for the installation of the playground. This invitation has also been extended to local business and representatives.

Why: Physical fitness is essential to social and emotional well being. Students who are physically active learn better and are more focused during the school day. Currently, Linden Avenue Middle School does not have an outside structure that supports physical activity.

How: All playground equipment was purchased through a grant at no cost to the community or the district. We are looking for community support to offset the cost of the installation.
